On Saturday, May 21, 2022, at 10:00am, Cardinal Cupich will ordain Deacon Colm Mitchell and Deacon Joseph Brom, SJC as priests to serve the local Church. Joseph Brom is being ordained as a member of Canons Regular of St. John Cantius and will be assigned to serve that community. Colm Mitchell will be assigned a church in the Archdiocese of Chicago.
